IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

Parents are requested to guide their ward in the view of the following points:

- 1. Continuous & Comprehensive Evaluation is a school based evaluation that covers all aspects of student's development i.e. Scholastic- specific subject areas and coscholastic-life skills, attitude & values and co-curricular activities.
- Academic session is divided into two terms. Each term consists of two formatives & one summative assessment.
